




THE CHALLENGE

TIJEC offers something unique that today's youth severely lack and desperately crave:




THE STATE OF JEWISH EDUCATION

In the GTA, 34% of Jewish children attend Jewish Day School, 33% attend supplementary Jewish education, and another 33% receive no Jewish education whatsoever.
